

God's work. Our hands. Outreach and Wellness wants to thank all of the volunteers that came down to Fellowship Hall for our Phoenix backpack packing event that took place Sunday September 12th, 2021. With your help we were able to pack 200 weekend food bags for October and November totaling 400 meals.

It's a big job but many hands make light work. It cost \$250/month to provide a weekend food pack to 100 children. Our goal is to raise \$2250.00, so far we have raised \$843.51 of our goal. United provides food bags one weekend a month through the school year. Your generosity feeds hungry kids. Thank you!

Many of you have donated Orthopedic Equipment – Items that have been donated range from wheelchairs, walkers, crutches, boots, knee braces, canes, etc.... 








## \*\*Important COVID-19 update!\*\*
