transition, sharing a sign of God's love and presence.


United folks gathering to study books, scripture, and faith practices striving to grow in faith and knowledge, knowing that growing in faith is a life long adventure.


Generous people, who support the work of the worldwide church, our neighbors across the street, and all this congregation does to live, learn, and share the love of Jesus Christ.

Among the Maasai, A Memoir

Book are available for sale in the church office for \$15.00. Proceeds from the sale of the book support the education of Maasai girls.

About the book: In 1999, Juliet Cutler leaves the United States to teach at the first school for Maasai girls in East Africa, making the beginning of a twenty-year journey to empower young Maasai women through education. Working alongside local teachers, Cutler is transformed by the community she finds in Tanzania and by witnessing the life-changing impacts of education on her students - many of whom face staggering poverty, forced marriages, genital cutting, and other forms of gender based violence.


